



2025 Swan CLC Team League

1. **Time.** 4/14 to 5/16; Registration deadline 4/12
2. **Venue.** Swan Ping Pong Club at 2600 Lafayette Street, San Clara, CA 95050. The club will designate tables for tournament use. Teams are welcome to play matches on their corporation campus by mutual agreement, with advance notifications sent to the organizers.
3. **Entry Form.** Submit entry forms to james.chai@gmail.com or (408) 636-3262.
4. **Entry Fees.** \$100 per team. **Payment.** Zelle: pingpong.community@gmail.com, **Venmo:** @SWANPPC (Last four digits of phone numbers 9919). No Paypal. Ensure that you include the event and your team name in your payment.
5. **Reward.** A Perpetual Trophy for Division 1 1st place. Medals for each Division's 1st, 2nd, 3d places. No cash prize.
6. **Eligibility.** Players must be employed by the same corporation or parent corporation to form a team. One corporation can have multiple teams. Interns with corporate-issued badges are eligible. Former employees or retirees are not eligible. A team consists of 3 to 5 players. The roster can't be changed after 4/12. Ensure to have 5 players on the roster if some players on your team can't play for all matches.
7. **Ratings:** This is not a USATT sanctioned event. No active USATT membership is required. Match results do not impact one's USATT ratings. There are no rating restrictions for players. We will determine a team's seeding based on the sum of the three top players' ratings. Individual rating is one's higher tournament and league ratings. The latest rating suffices if the difference between one's tournament and league ratings is more than 250 points.
8. **Format.** We will divide teams into two divisions according to their seeding. Divisions with less than 11 teams may play a giant group round-robin to determine the final positions. Divisions with 12 or more teams will start with a group round-robin, followed by a single-elimination playoffs. Each match consists of five sets: single, single, doubles, single, and single. The match is over when one team wins three sets. Each set plays the best of five. During each match, each team designates one player who must play two singles, and others can play up to one single and one double. Refer to Table 2 for the lineup and score details.
9. **Schedule.** Captains arrange mutually agreed dates and times to play their matches from 4/14 to 5/16. We may make arrangements to help complete all matches on weekends if necessary.
10. **Equipment.** We will use Butterfly tables and Nittaku 3-star premium 40+ white balls.
11. **Rule.** The organization committee reserves rights for all tournament-related matters, including ratings, divisions, format, schedule, and dispute resolution.
12. **Tiebreaker:** Refer to Tables 3 and 4 for tiebreaker calculations.
13. **Indemnity Agreement.** I fully understand that table tennis activities involve risks and dangers of severe body injuries. By signing this agreement, I fully accept and assume all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur from participating in the 2025 CLC Table Tennis Team Tournament. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Swan Ping Pong Club, the tournament organizers, volunteers, and all individuals, teams, and sponsors involved in this event. I agree to abide by all the tournament rules and decisions made by the organizers. I

Note:

- 1) Team captains write down their players' names and order on the scoresheet, blind to the other team, before the match, which can not be changed after both teams see the matchup.
- 2) One player (A and X) on each team must play two singles, and others can play up to one single and one double.
- 3) Record individual set scores for singles and doubles as 3:0, 3:1, or 3:2. Do not record game scores such as 11:8 or 13:11. Record the final match score between two teams as 3:0, 3:1, or 3:2.
- 4) Two team captains verify the accuracy and completeness of scores, sign, date, and submit the scoresheet.
